

CRITIQUES OF MIND/BODY DICHOTOMY

- Body is not a container, nor an object possessed by the Self
- From have a body to be a body and do a body
- From the body to bodies



WHY DOES EMBODIMENT MATTER NOW?

- Material and discursive
- Otherwise unknowable topics
- Possibilities for analysis and representation
- Crystallization, or another facet of validity
- Address multiple publics and policymakers
- Researcher satisfaction




